Dear IASC Member Schools,

I hope you are all as excited as I am to start the 2019-2020 school year! As the IASC Secretary, I am in charge of the Honor Council Book program. This program works to recognize your student council for all the hard work and dedication you put into your school. To be a part of the program, all your school needs to do is create a book, following the provided score card, documenting what you have accomplished throughout the year. These books will be graded during the 2020 IASC State Convention by me along with a committee of delegates. As recognition for the school's hard work and for making the Honor Council Book itself, based on the amount of points earned, a certificate or plaque will be awarded.

This year, there are four options for the Honor Council Book. You can complete a full hard copy Honor Council Book, or you can complete a full E-Book, which is done electronically. There is also a Mini-Book option, a smaller version of the Honor Council Book. This is great for schools that have not participated in the Honor Council Program before. The Mini-book can also be completed digitally as an E-Book. I heavily encourage you to participate in one of these options. ***Please note that there is an updated 2019-2020 scorecard. Do not use a scorecard from previous years as a guideline.***

The Honor Council Book Program is an excellent way to recognize your council's dedication to your school and community, and can be used as a tool to motivate growth within your council. Along with this letter, you will find your application, and an information packet. If your school sends in its application postmarked before November 4th, 2019, your school will receive a 10 bonus point certificate. Once I receive your completed application, you will be sent all of the necessary information to complete your Honor Council Book.
