The Definition of an Honor Delegate

Service Projects:

Provide goods or a service for the conventions. This can include but is not limited to folders, banners, certificates, or other useful items to help the host school, Columbia High School, make the convention run smoothly.

Hall of Ideas:

Make a free-standing presentation to showcase a unique activity or service your local council does. This display and handouts are set up so other schools can get ideas to take back to their own councils.

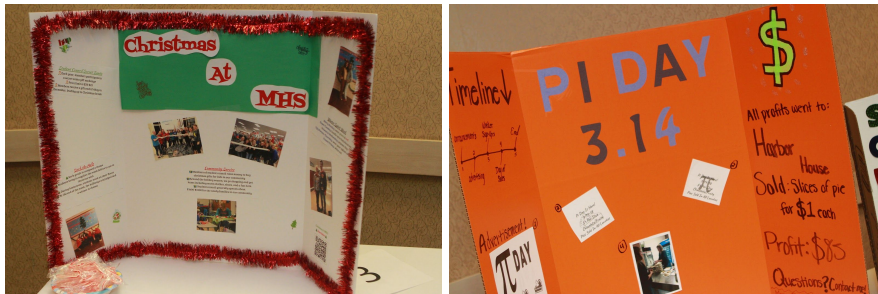
