Dear Student Council Advisor,

This school year marks the first year that we are back to, somewhat, normalcy! With that, planning for this year's IASC State Convention has already started. This year's convention will be held on May 4-6, 2023; this year's theme is "Ignite Your Leadership". We are expecting this year's convention to be one for the books! So, therefore, we would like to let you know about some opportunities that your students can be a part of at this year's convention: **Honor Delegates**.

Honor Delegates are an essential key role in the State Convention. It is our job, as the 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents of the IASC, to recommend students for the different Honor Delegate positions. We ask you, as advisors, to encourage your students into these positions; moreover, we ask that you ask especially those students who have exceptional leadership skills, or any of the other qualities that the different honor delegate positions would require.

As an Honor Delegate, students would have the opportunity to meet new people, participate in new experiences, and learn both leadership skills and more about student council. Committee members will be able to learn, experience parliamentary procedures in meetings, and contribute to the IASC. Students in the numerous other positions will have the opportunity to share leadership and wisdom among their peers. Again, we ask you to encourage all students to fill out the Honor Delegate Application and pursue this opportunity.

Please remind students that they can only apply for **ONE** position. In addition, please remember that only one person, per school, can apply to each of the committee positions (Credentials, Constitution, Honor Book Evaluation). All other positions such as Discussion Group Leader, Recorder, and Roundtable Moderator can have **UNLIMITED** applicants as wanted. In addition to that, there can be **AS MANY** 2nd VP positions applied for as wanted.
