Remember that both advisor and student **MUST** attend the Credentials Committee meeting in Bloomington, Illinois, on January 12, 2019, to complete the interview process if you are running for an elected position.

After a student or advisor applies for a position, specific information pertaining to that position will be emailed to the candidate, (i.e. job description, credentials, etc.). Please be reminded that your school must be a member of the IASC organization and a member of your district to run a candidate for office. Membership information is on the IASC website. Advisor, please remember that if your student becomes a member of the board that you **MUST** attend all meetings with your student.
